Hank Kohler from Ames will be our speaker. Hank grew up on a family farm in northwest Iowa and enjoyed going on his family's annual fishing trip to Otter Tail County, MN. Little did he know that he would embark on two amazing canoe trips from this yery same location later in his life.

In 1979, Hank decided to canoe from Otter Tail County to Hudson Bay with three of his friends. This trip was later detailed in the book *This Water Goes North. 43* years later, Hank set out from Otter Tail County once more, but this time he was headed down the mighty Mississippi River to the Gulf of Mexico. He wanted to make his trip a fundraiser for conservation programs. The result was One4Water, a fundraiser for the National Mississippi River Museum and Aquarium in Dubuque, IA.

Book Club



The book club selection for September is *The Indigo Girl* by Natasha Boyd. Discussion will be on Thursday, September 14 at 10 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Summary: "The year is 1739. Eliza Lucas is sixteen years old when her father leaves her in charge of their family's three plantations in rural South Carolina and then proceeds to bleed the estates dry in pursuit of his military ambitions. Soon her family

is in danger of losing everything.

Upon hearing how much the French pay for indigo dye, Eliza believes it's the key to their salvation. But everyone tells her it's impossible, and no one will share the secret to making it.

So begins an incredible story of love, dangerous and hidden friendships, ambition, betrayal, and sacrifice.

Based on historical documents, including Eliza's letters, this is a historical fiction account of how a teenage girl produced indigo dye, which became one of the largest exports out of South Carolina, an export that laid the foundation for the incredible wealth of several Southern families who still live on today. "

We will be going on our annual book club trip on Thursday, October 12. This year we will be traveling to Winterset to visit the Iowa Quilt Museum. This fall's rotating exhibit will feature Kaffe Fassett, an Americanborn British-based artist that is well known for his colorful designs in the decorative arts.

To prepare for the trip we will read *Forget Me Knot* by Mary Marks.

Summary: "Welcome to San Fernando Valley, California, where Martha Rose and her coterie of quilters are enjoying life on the good side of retirement—until murder pulls a stitch out of their plans..."






